

My grandfather was an old stock man who used to tell me that “there is no such thing as a good chestnut”... and I always had repeated that to my friends so when I saw Henry for the first time and said “he is my dream horse” Michelle Goding quite rightly commented that 1. H was a chestnut and I hate chestnuts and 2. he looked like a skinny orange giraffe.

Either way, we loved each other from the first moment together and in March 2013 he came to live with me. He drove me insane – as you all know. If he could hurt himself he did, feeding was an issue because anything that could put on weight made him hot, feed supplements to calm him made him dangerous. If I put my leg on he exploded forward and up (cattle prod had been used on him I suspect) and he had such a good work ethic as a race horse that any canter turned into a very fast gallop. At the start, I came off maybe twice a week which is not ideal from such a height and because I had just turned 50. He famously pelted me so high in a dressage lesson in club one day that I did a flip and landed on my feet causing Melinda Johnson and the rest of the crew in the clubrooms to hold up score cards on my gymnastic dismount. (Apparently it was worth an 8).

I loved riding him and he was soft and floated and when he was good I rode by telepathy. His lovely looks made him stand out in the show ring though he hated being plaited and made up and as my partner said “plays up worse when you make him look like a poof” but we won lots of nice ribbons, he also chased cows, was pretty good with obstacles, won at dressage and obviously Nav Riding



I just want to thank everyone for their messages, flowers and plants and support on the sudden passing of Henry. Henry to me exemplified the challenges of our sport and our relationship with our animals. He literally was like a husband to me. Most of you have witnessed me “arguing with him” about his poor behaviour and him flapping his lips arguing back until I just laughed at him and forgave him for whatever he did. He was never malicious, it was just all good fun. He could be frustrating, a challenge to stay on- or the best horse I have ever ridden. I don't think that I will ever get over missing the bop bop bop of his lips as he did a happy dance at feed time every day and the kiss on the cheek he gave me after he was fed. I am so lucky to have such a character to remember but he has left big shoes for my poor young horse to fill.
